After crossing the Trinity River, you will cross Perimeter, Canada and Singleton. Inwood becomes Hampton. Before you get to I-30, turn right on West Commerce. Then, take a left onto Postal Way. Before you reach I-30, you will see the Peacock Alley Outlet on your left. There will be signs to show you the way. When you pull into the parking lot, please go to the far back loading dock.
