School of Nursing and College of Pharmacy. She is the past Vice-Chair of the Consortium of Academic Health Centers for Integrative Medicine. Dr. Kreitzer has served as Principal Investigator for numerous grants and currently co-directs an NIH-funded clinical research fellowship program. She teaches courses in research and optimal healing environments and is a tenured professor in the School of Nursing, having earned her Doctoral degree in Health Services Research and Masters and Bachelors degrees in Nursing.

Take US-12.
