KC Connors, CFA, CAIA, Connors, CFA, CAIA, Jeffrey Slocum and Associates

Mrs. Connors joined Slocum in 1995, and has more than 20 years of investment experience. KC has expertise in plan consolidation and mergers, risk budgeting, liability-driven investing, and alternative investments as they apply to operating, foundation and pension assets. KC is a member of the firm's Executive Committee, and acts as a liaison for the Slocum hedge fund team. KC is a frequent presenter on the topics of alternative investments, the unique challenges of healthcare investment programs, and financial/liability strategies, and co-authored Risk Facts, which was published in the June 2006 issue of HFM, Healthcare Financial Management association magazine.

In addition, KC has a patent pending for an integrated liquidity model for operating and debt liabilities and investment assets. Prior to joining Slocum, KC worked at Wyatt Investment Consulting, Ennis Knupp Associates and Comerica. As a consultant, KC managed client relationships, created investment policy statements, advised on asset allocation and selection of investment managers, At Comerica, KC performed quantitative securities analysis and research.

KC received her undergraduate degree in Decision Sciences from Indiana University, holds an MBA (with Honors) from the University of Chicago, is a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) Charterholder and Chartered Alternative Investment Analyst (CAIA) Charterholder. KC is Chair of the Visitation School Board of Directors and is a Board member of the Courage Center.

Robbie Burkhart, CFA, Principal, Blue Rock Advisors, Inc.

Mr. Burkhart's primary responsibilities include investment manager research and evaluation. Mr. Burkhart is a member of Blue Rock's investment committee and has been in the investment business since 1997. Prior to joining Blue Rock Advisors, Inc., he managed corporate cash and pension assets for ALLETE, Inc. He joined their investment group in 1998 and served as the lead analyst of alternative investment strategies for a portfolio in excess of \$200 million. In addition, in early 1999 he co-developed a risk arbitrage strategy and actively managed that strategy as its portfolio manager from inception. In early 2002 he co-developed a fundamental and quantitative LSMNE strategy and served as the portfolio manager from inception. Prior to joining the ALLETE investment group, Mr. Burkhart worked as an internal auditor for ALLETE performing financial and operational audits of ALLETE subsidiaries located throughout North America.

Mr. Burkhart graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Superior with a B.S. in Accounting in May 1997 and the University of Minnesota Carlson School of Management with an MBA in March 2006. He is a member of the Beta Gamma Sigma national honor society. He passed the Uniform Certified Public Accountant examination in May 1998 and received the "President's Award" from the Minnesota Society of Certified Public Accountants for receiving the top score in the state of Minnesota on that exam. Mr. Burkhart is a CFA charterholder. He is a member of the CFA Society of Minnesota and the CFA Institute.

Jason Cross, Ph. D., Partner and Co-Portfolio Manager, Whitebox Advisors, LLC

Mr. Cross leads the quantitative research and applications at Whitebox. He graduated from the University of British Colombia with B.S. in Mathematics and Statistics. He also holds an MBA from the University of Chicago and a Ph.D. in Statistics from Yale University. His dissertation was published in the Journal of Mathematical Finance and made a significant contribution to "universal portfolio theory," which deals with portfolio returns over an infinite time horizon. Prior to joining Whitebox, Mr. Cross spent two years working with Nobel Laureate Myron Scholes at Oak Hill Platinum Partners where he developed quantitative models for long/short equity strategies.

Maria Loucks, CFA, Senior Managing Director and Senior Portfolio Manager, Black River Asset Management, LLC Mrs. Loucks responsible for setting and implementing the Emerging Market Debt relative value strategy. Prior to joining the Investment Adviser in 2004, Mrs. Loucks was the Co-Head of the Emerging Markets Debt ("EMD") Group at UBS Global Asset Management. During her time at UBS Global Asset Management from 1995 to 2004, Mrs. Loucks developed the quantitative models used for instrument selection and risk management in EMD portfolios. She wrote two articles about EMD portfolio management which appear in textbooks edited by Frank J. Fabozzi.

Mrs. Loucks graduated with a B.A. in Economics and a B.S. in Applied Mathematics from the University of Chicago in 1996.

Mrs. Page has been actively involved in distressed debt and event-driven investing since the mid-1980's and has dedicated all of her business efforts to the management of the Värde Funds since co-founding the firm with George Hicks and Greg McMillan in 1993. She specializes in corporate and special situation investing and oversees corporate investing in Europe. Under Marcia's leadership, Värde has invested billions of dollars in publicly traded securities, and been actively involved in reorganizing numerous small- to mid-size companies.

From 1981 until 1987, Tom was employed in the Domestic Soybean Processing Division at Cargill in both trading and managerial roles.
