She joined BNP Paribas in 2000 as Senior Banker- Financial Institutions Group in charge of a portfolio of major French Financial Institutions. In 2006, she became Global Head of Business Development and Organisation, Financial Institutions Group ("FIG"), in July 2007 Deputy Head of FIG, Head of FIG International and is since June 2010 Managing Director, Global Head of FIG.

Laure is a graduate of I.E.P Aix en Provence (Political Sciences Institute of Aix en Provence) and holds a D.E.A (Master¹s) in International Public Law.

Brigitte Baumann, CEO, Go Beyond Ltd

Brigitte Baumann is the Founder and CEO of Go Beyond, the early-stage investing services firm which provides cross border investment opportunities, syndication/pooling, due diligence, investment monitoring services and training/coaching. She is a Business Angel and passionate about creating a sustainable world by investing and mentoring Impact entrepreneurs.

Brigitte is currently serving her second term as President of EBAN (the European trade association for Business Angel Networks and Seed Funds www.eban.org). She has been a member of the World President Organization www.ypowpo.org since 1998 and leads its Business Angel interest group. She holds a B.Sc. in Chemical Engineering from Tufts University, Boston and an MBA in Finance from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania. Brigitte is the subject of a Harvard Business School case study and lectures at IMD.

Sonia Rameau, Publica, Business Angel

Sonia started her career in 1992 at Eurest France in Paris then Eurest International in London where she spent four years in charge of marketing and development for catering in schools, councils and large corporations.

In 1996, she joined BusinessMeetings.com, an internet start-up dedicated to business travels, as Business Development Director. In October 1998, she launched SRNet Consulting, a consulting company working with internet start-ups helping them define and implement their marketing strategy and business development.

She became a private investor in Notrefamille.com in 2000 and slowly got more involved in the business, becoming Marketing and Business Development Director, Procurement then Vice CEO. NotreFamille.com (including Genealogie.com and Cadeaux.com), has been listed on Alternext since March 2007, and is the first internet portal dedicated to family life in France.

Early 2009, Sonia went back to consulting for startups whilst continuing her involvement with a dozen private Business Angels investments. In April 2010, Sonia launched Publica, a new internet startup dedicated to the distribution of digital documents.

Sonia graduated from the Ecole Hôtelière de Lausanne. She also holds a MBA from Lyon Business School (CESMA) and Cranfield University (UK). She is a keen traveler and an amateur sculptor.

Daniela Soukup, Business Angel

Daniela started her career in 1997 in Colorado, USA as software engineer with TRW Inc. In 2000, she joined 2 McDATA Corporation, still in Colorado, as a Project Manager, then 7 Southern California Edison, the largest electric utility in California, providing reliable service and community involvement, as Manager, Strategic Asset Management. In 2009, she joined Emerson Process Management, Switzerland, a \$21bn global diversified manufacturer of technology and engineering solutions for large-scale industries, as Strategic Planning Manager for Europe.

Daniela holds a Bachelor Degree in Computer Sciences, State University, Bucharest, Romania, a Masters of Science in Computer Science, Colorado University at Boulder, Colorado, USA, and graduated in 2008 from IMD Lausanne MBA. She speaks fluent English, Romanian, French and Italian.
