Previously, Ms. Ambrosiadou worked at KPMG Management Consulting in Bahrain. Between 1983 and 1989, she held a number of international management positions with British Petroleum in London, Sydney, and the US. She served as Chairman of the Parents Association at the Hellenic College in London from Sep. 2001 until March 2004. She serves as a Trustee of the Oxford Philomusica, a Patron of ARK (Absolute Return for Kids) and a Patron of the Independent Film Trust. She serves as a Member of Advisory Board at Cranfield School of Management, Cranfield University. Ms. Ambrosiadou is an FSA Registered Representative and an NFA Associated Person. She holds a Degree in Chemical Engineering, a M.Sc. in Technology and Development from Imperial College at London, and a M.B.A. from Cranfield University in 1988.

Jane Buchan, CEO, PAAMCO

Jane Buchan is a Managing Director and the Chief Executive Officer of Pacific Alternative Asset Management Company, LLC ("PAAMCO"). As CEO, Jane is responsible for overall business strategy and firm direction. In addition, she is the Sector Specialist responsible for the evaluation and management of fixed income relative value in the various PAAMCO portfolios. In addition to her work in fixed income, she has also focused on strategic investment issues for pension plans with a particular focus on structuring alternative investment programs using core fiduciary principles, and has numerous professional publications in the field of alternative investment strategies. Jane is also a member of the Investment Management, Risk Management, and Account Management Committees. Jane has twenty-two years of experience in investment management and portfolio construction with institutional investors.

Throughout her thirty-year investment career, Ms. Haugerud has acquired expertise across all asset classes, through posts in the U.S., Canada, the U.K., Switzerland, Australia, and Hong Kong. She began her tenure in financial markets by trading cash commodity markets in the United States and Canada for Cargill Inc. and Continental Grain. Her interests in the relationship between financial markets and geopolitics led to her first international post in Geneva Switzerland, where she ultimately served as Cargill's Foreign Exchange Trading Manager. During her 13-year career at Cargill, Ms. Haugerud developed expertise in a broad and diverse range of securities by assuming the positions of Manager of the US Fixed Income trading desk, Minneapolis, MN; Financial Division Manager of the Melbourne Australia Office; board membership of Cargill Australia; and finally Vice President/Structural Trading Manager at Cargill's corporate headquarters in Minneapolis, MN. Following her years at Cargill, Ms. Haugerud managed proprietary trading desks at institutions including Natwest Markets in Hong Kong and Hunter Douglas N.A. in the U.S.

Ms. Haugerud's insight into how global markets are affected by the psychology and relationships of macroeconomic trends makes her a sought-after speaker and panelist at global investment events. Ms. Haugerud has been interviewed on CNBC, CNN and the PBS Nightly Business Report, and has also been

profiled in Barron's, eFinancial News, Forbes Magazine, ForbesLife Executive Woman, MAR Futures, Time and Trader Monthly. She is active in the community of women and business leaders, and an active advocate for numerous global education initiatives.

She graduated summa cum laude in philosophy and magna cum laude in general studies from the University of Colorado, was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, and was voted Most Outstanding Graduate in the School of Arts and Sciences.
