Biography

Peter Tomsen (Ret.), Former Special Envoy to the Afghan Resistance

Peter Tomsen was President George H.W. Bush's Special Envoy to the Afghan Resistance with the rank of Ambassador from 1989 to 1992. Ambassador Tomsen has served in Thailand, Vietnam, India, China, Armenia and the Soviet Union. He was United States Deputy Chief of Mission in China from 1986 to 1989, Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for East Asian Affairs from 1992 to 1995, and the United States Ambassador to Armenia from 1995 to 1998. Among the awards Ambassador Tomsen has received are three Presidential Meritorious Service Awards, a State Department Superior and two Meritorious Honor awards. Ambassador Tomsen's book, *The Wars of Afghanistan: Messianic Terrorism, Tribal Conflicts, and the Failures of Great Powers*, was recently released and has been described as the most authoritative account yet of Afghanistan's wars over the past 30 years.
