Chuck Clough, Founder/Portfolio Manager, Clough Capital Partners, LP Charles I. Clough, Jr. has been active in the securities and investment business for over 30 years. His experience covers most analytical functions from research analyst to portfolio management. Currently, Mr. Clough is a founder and portfolio manager at Clough Capital Partners, which he founded in 2000. Clough Capital Partners serves as investment manager to a number of hedge funds, mutual funds, and other managed accounts. From 1987 through January 2000, Mr. Clough was Chief Investment Strategist at Merrill Lynch & Co. Inc., where he was responsible for directing the global investment strategy research effort for the world's largest investment firm. Using a theme based investment approach, Mr. Clough advised many of the world's top institutions and investors on portfolio strategy.

He was named to the Institutional Investor All-America Research Team for 12 consecutive years and earned first place rankings on three separate occasions. Mr. Clough has been consistently recognized as a top strategist in areas such as US equities, global investments and fixed income.

Prior to his tenure at Merrill Lynch, Mr. Clough was Director of Investment Policy and Chief Strategist at Cowen & Co. Previously, he had been Director of Research and Portfolio Manager at The Boston Company, Portfolio Manager at Colonial Management Associates and Vice President and Senior Research Analyst for Donaldson, Lufkin & Jenrette and Alliance Capital Management Company. Mr. Clough serves on the boards of a number of educational, hospital and charitable institutions, including his alma mater, Boston College. He is also an ordained Deacon in the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Boston and serves in that capacity at his local parish in Concord, Massachusetts. Mr. Clough graduated magna cum laude in history from Boston College and earned an MBA at the University of Chicago.

For five consecutive years, Ms. Bartels has been voted to the Institutional Investor All-American Research Team. She appears on CNBC and Bloomberg and is often quoted in various publications including the Wall Street Journal, Financial Times and Barron's.

Ms. Bartels earned a Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts degree in Economics from Fordham University.
