Valérie Plagnol, Head of Global Research, Credit Suisse

Her career began in 1990 as an economist for Nomura, Tokyo covering France. In 1994, she became chief economist for Credit Suisse First Boston, London, dealing with France and Japan. Moving then to HSBC France (CCF) as Head of Strategy, running the market research department, as well as managing the emerging market team. In November 2010 she joined Cr dit Suisse, after 10 years as Head of Strategy, responsible for overall market analysis at Cr dit Mutuel CIC.

Val rie Plagnol was a member of le Conseil d'Analyse  conomique for the First Minister of France (2006-2010).

Education: Sciences-Po Paris and the University of Keio, Tokyo. Val rie speaks not only French and English, but Japanese. She is a regular contributor to the public debate through the publication of court cases and commentaries in the press. Val rie Plagnol has been awarded the Chevalier de l'ordre de la L gion d'honneur and the ordre National du M rite.

Gilles Meshaka, Portfolio Manager, Exane

He has managed the flagship fund of Exane since 2011, and began as a co-portfolio manager in 2010 of the internal fund of hedge funds Pl iade.

To highlight some of the roles Gilles has held during his career in France, he was Head of European Equities at Fortis Investment Management (2002) as well as Ixis Asset Management (1995), and was an European Equity Portfolio Manager for BGP (1994) and GMF (1990), an Equity Sales-Analyst for CCF (1988), and in London worked as a Buy-Side Analyst for Schroders (1987).
