Matthew Edmonds is the President and Principal of Hutchin Hill Capital, a \$2.2 billion multi-strategy hedge fund. Prior to joining Hutchin Hill, Mr. Edmonds was the Chief Executive Officer of TRB Advisors LP, a global direct investment business formed by Timothy R. Barakett, the founder and former Chairman & CEO of Atticus Capital LP. From 2003 to 2010, Mr. Edmonds was a Partner, President & Chief Operating Officer and member of the Management Committee at Atticus Capital LP, a leading global investment management firm, with peak assets under management exceeding \$20 billion. Prior to joining Atticus, Mr. Edmonds spent nine years at Morgan Stanley & Co. Mr. Edmonds' experience at Morgan Stanley included mergers and acquisitions, corporate finance and general management. From 1990 to 1993, Mr. Edmonds was an attorney at Mallesons Stephen Jagues, a leading Australian commercial law firm. Mr. Edmonds is a non-executive member of the Board of Directors of Castleton Commodities International (CCI), a merchant energy business, formerly known as Louis Dreyfus Energy Services. Mr. Edmonds is a Trustee of the JAMAKEPE Foundation, a private family foundation focused on enhancing Australian-American relations via educational scholarships and grants, and a member of the Board of Directors of The University of Melbourne USA Foundation, Mr. Edmonds received Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Laws (Honors) degrees from the University of Melbourne, Australia and holds a Masters of Business Administration (Beta Gamma Sigma) from Columbia Business School, New York. Mr. Edmonds lives in New York with his wife and two teenaged children.

Alexis Halaby, Senior Vice President, The D.E. Shaw Group

Alexis Halaby is a senior vice president of D. E. Shaw & Co., L.P. and a senior member of the D. E. Shaw group's investor relations department, in which capacity she co-manages marketing and client servicing for the firm's alternative investment platform and benchmark-relative institutional asset management business. Ms. Halaby also interfaces extensively with members of the firm's front office in coordinating the dissemination of investment information to investor relations staff. Prior to assuming her investor relations role in 2008, Ms. Halaby spent more than four years as a member of the D. E. Shaw group's fixed-income trading unit, where she traded G10 sovereign debt and interest rate derivatives and conducted investment research. She received her B.S. in biological sciences from Stanford University in 2003.

Katy Hoffman, Director, External Public Markets, The Teacher Retirement System of Texas

Katy Hoffman is a Director on the External Public Markets team at the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, a \$128 billion pension system serving 1.3 million active and retired educators and their families. Ms. Hoffman is a portfolio manager for the Trust's externally managed public market assets, including \$29 billion in traditional long-oriented equities and \$11 billion in hedge funds. Additionally, she managed the Trust's opportunistic credit allocation. Prior to her work on External Public, Ms. Hoffman developed TRS enterprise risk management system, initiated the fund's use of derivative instruments and helped to develop our existing strategic asset allocation. She started at TRS in 2004 as an investment grade credit analyst. Prior to joining TRS, Ms. Hoffman was based in NYC where she was a credit analyst for the Credit Portfolio Group of JPM which managed the bank's retained credit risk from direct loan exposure and derivative transactions. She also worked for 5 years in high technology brand management and marketing research. Ms. Hoffman received an MBA from Vanderbilt University, and a BA in Mathematics from Trinity University.

Jeff Willardson, Managing Director, PAAMCO

Jeff Willardson, CFA, CQF is a Managing Director. As a member of the four-person Portfolio Construction Group (PCG), his chief responsibility is to set top down portfolio strategy and construction across PAAMCO's diversified Moderate Multi Strategy (MMS) solution.
