M. Elaine Crocker is a member of the Board of Directors, President, and a member of the Investment Advisory Committee of Moore Capital Management, LP. Founded in 1989, Moore Capital currently has over 400 employees. As President, Ms. Crocker is responsible for administration of all areas of the firm, with the heads of finance, operations, legal, compliance, personnel, technology, and investor relations all reporting to her. Known in the industry for her ability to identify and nurture talented traders, Ms. Crocker is also responsible for the selection of portfolio managers at Moore Capital. Prior to joining Moore in January 1995, she was a Managing Director and an Executive Vice President of Commodities Corporation (U.S.A) N.V. ("CC (U.S.A.)"). Her responsibilities included the planning, selection and development of CC (U.S.A.)'s trading, research, risk control and legal and compliance activities, and she was also responsible for portfolio selection for internal capital and managed fund products. She joined Commodities Corporation in 1970. Ms. Crocker received a B.S. in Business Administration from Sophia University International College in Tokyo, Japan.

Dawn Fitzpatrick, Global Head and CIO, Group Managing Director, O'Connor

Dawn Fitzpatrick is currently Global Head and Chief Investment Officer of O'Connor, an alternative asset management firm based in New York. As CIO, she oversees the firm's portfolio management, capital allocation and risk management as well as communicating with firm's investors. Dawn also serves as Head of the Tactical Trading Strategy within O'Connor's flagship fund, the O'Connor Global Multi-Strategy Alpha Fund. Prior to her current role, she served as head of various teams within O'Connor's numerous investment strategies.

O'Connor, which is wholly owned by UBS AG, has a 37-year history of liquid relative value investing within equities, credit, convertibles and derivatives with approximately \$5.4 billion in assets under management. The firm has over 140 professionals with offices in New York, Chicago, London, Hong Kong and Singapore.

Dawn began her career with O'Connor & Associates in 1992. During her tenure, she has specialized in investing in equities, equity options, index options, convertible arbitrage and merger arbitrage as well as derivatives. Dawn holds a B.S. from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School of Business and is a member of the UBS Global Asset Management Executive Committee and Americas Risk Committee. Dawn is a member of The Federal Reserve Bank of New York's Investor Advisory Committee on Financial Markets. Dawn was listed as one of the most powerful women on Wall Street by Business Insider.

Stephanie Ruhle, Anchor and Managing Editor, Bloomberg Television, Editor-at-Large, Bloomberg News Stephanie Ruhle is an anchor and managing editor for Bloomberg Television and editor-at-large for Bloomberg News, based in New York. She serves as co-host of "Market Makers," airing from 8-10am ET. Ruhle regularly interviews industry titans such as Goldman Sachs CEO Lloyd Blankfein, hedge fund managers David Tepper and Stanley Druckenmiller, NBA star Kobe Bryant, former Vice President Al Gore and music moguls Sean "Diddy" Combs and Kanye West.

Prior to joining Bloomberg, Ruhle served as a Managing Director in Global Markets Senior Relationship Management at Deutsche Bank. There, she oversaw relationships for some of Deutsche Bank's largest hedge fund clients.

Ruhle plays an active role in women's leadership and business leader development. She founded the Corporate Investment Bank (CIB) Women's Network and co-chaired the Women on Wall Street (WOWS) steering committee. Ruhle is also a member of the board of trustees for Girls Inc. NYC and formerly served on the corporate councils of I-Mentor and The White House Project, a non-profit organization working to advance women in business, government and media. She currently serves on the board and advises for "React To Film," an issue-based documentary film series.

Ruhle began her career at Credit Suisse, where she was the highest producing credit derivatives salesperson in the U.S. Ruhle earned her bachelor's degree in International Business from Lehigh University. Under her major, she studied in Guatemala, Italy and Kenya.
