She served as Board Treasurer of the American Council of Young Political Leaders and was elected Secretary General of the Atlantic Association of Young Political Leaders (NATO). She is a member of the National Association of Corporate Directors, and serves on the Board of the National Writing Project, and the Island Press Advisory Board. Ms. Mannion has also served as an advisor to political campaigns for numerous federal, state and local candidates. She is a frequent speaker on leadership and diversity issues.
