Genevieve Kahr, Founder & Managing Partner, Ailanthus Capital Management

Genevieve Kahr is the Founder and Managing Partner of Ailanthus Capital Management, a fundamental long-short hedge fund focused on small and mid-cap companies in the global technology, media and telecom sectors. The fund launched in October 2015. Prior to Ailanthus, Genevieve was a Partner at Jericho Capital; she was the fund's first pre-launch hire in 2009 and helped to grow the business from \$36 million to \$2 billion in assets under management over the following six years. She began her career at TPG-Axon Capital. Genevieve graduated Magna cum Laude from Yale with a B.A. and M.A in East Asian Languages & Literatures. She serves as Treasurer and a Director of the Board of the Brooklyn Community Foundation.

Maria Vassalou Ph.D., Partner & Portfolio Manager, Perella Weinberg Partners

Maria Vassalou is Partner at Perella Weinberg Partners and the Portfolio Manager for the PWP Global Macro Fund. Dr. Vassalou joined Perella Weinberg Partners from MIO Partners, a subsidiary of McKinsey & Company, where as a Portfolio Manager she managed a similar global macro investment strategy in a dedicated legal entity, and as Head of Asset Allocation she provided counsel on allocation for liquid assets within MIO's portfolio. Prior to joining MIO, Dr. Vassalou was a Global Macro Portfolio Manager at SAC Capital Advisors, LP. She joined SAC from Soros Fund Management where she was responsible for global quantitative research, as well as the development and management of global quantitative trading strategies. Prior to her career in asset management, Dr. Vassalou was an Associate Professor of Finance at Columbia Business School which she joined in 1995 and where she established many of the investment principles she employs today. Dr. Vassalou is a Past President of the European Finance Association and was the Chair of the 2008 European Finance Association Meetings. A Research Affiliate of the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) in London for many years, Dr. Vassalou is a past member of the Academic Advisory Board of the Vienna-based Guttmann Center of Competence in Portfolio Management. Her research focus has been on the interrelation of the macro-economy and financial markets with applications in hedge fund strategies. A frequent speaker to both academic and practitioner-oriented seminars and conferences, Vassalou has published in leading academic journals, such as the Journal of Finance, Journal of Financial Economics, Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis, Journal of Business, Journal of International Money and Finance, and the Journal of Economic Dynamics and Control. While she was on the faculty of Columbia University, she also served as a consultant to many premier hedge funds and asset management institutions in the U.S. and Europe. Dr. Vassalou received a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from the University of Athens and she holds a Ph.D. in Financial Economics from London Business School.

Lauren Taylor Wolfe is a Managing Director and Investing Partner at Blue Harbour Group, a \$3.8 billion activist investment firm that engages privately and collaboratively with management teams and boards to enhance shareholder value in North American companies. On top of her portfolio investment responsibilities, Lauren leads the firm's engagement with its largest investor, Californian pension fund CalSTRS. Prior to joining Blue Harbour Group in December 2007, she was a Portfolio Manager and Analyst at SIAR Capital and worked at Diamond Technology Partners, a strategic technology consulting firm. Lauren received an M.B.A. from The Wharton School at University of Pennsylvania in 2006 and a B.S. from Cornell University in 2000. Lauren is an avid supporter of the arts, particularly dance, and lives with her husband and two daughters in Tribeca, NYC.
