Cyril Demaria, Private Equity Expert

A renowned international private equity expert, Cyril Demaria combines in-depth practical and academic expertises. His extensive knowledge of the asset class over 16 years during which he held the positions at the Chief Investment Office of large Swiss bank where he is in charge of private markets research (buy-side), as founder and managing partner of a venture capital fund, as founder and Chief Investment Officer of Tiaré Investment Management AG, as an associate and portfolio manager in a private equity fund of funds and an insurance group. He started as an analyst in a venture capital fund in the US and Europe. He notably lectures at EADA, ESCP-Europe, HEC Paris and EDHEC. He collaborates as an expert with the Swiss Private Equity and Corporate Finance Association (SECA) and its European equivalent Invest Europe (formerly known as EVCA). Cyril holds a PhD from University of St Gallen, is a graduate from HEC Paris, and holds a Master's degree in European business law, a Master's degree in Geopolitics and a Bachelor in Political Sciences. He is the author of best selling books on private equity, notably "Introduction to private equity" (Wiley) running its second edition, translated in French (5th ed), Spanish, Portuguese and Mandarin; and "Private equity fund investments" (Palgrave).
