Marie-Cécile studied Art History at La Sorbonne in Paris (Bachelor) and Law (Master), specialising in Contemporary Art and Family Law. She moved to London in 2010 and started working at Christies Head Quarters in Pall Mall. In 2011, she started in the jewellery department at Christies South Kensington, where she was in charge of the catalogue for 4 years. South Kensington presents 10 jewellery auction per calendar year, each with approximately 300 lots. She was able to learn a lot by handling an exceptional number of jewels. At the same time, she went to evening classes and, in 2014, graduated from the Gemmology Association of Britain. In 2015, Marie-Cécile was invited to join the Geneva Jewellery department. She is working as a cataloguer here. Her job consists in describing each jewel that comes for auction in Geneva, as well as doing all the research and layout of the biannual catalogues.
