Eric Lauri has been a portfolio manager at exane asset management since 2012, leading the team-managed funds: Pleiade, Overdrive and Select.

From 2008 to 2011, he was head of the equity proprietary desk at Exane, in charge of a team of 10 long/short fundamental and statistical & quantitative arbitrage specialists.

From 2006 to 2008, Eric managed a long/short portfolio, a statistical arbitrage portfolio and long/short fundamental investments at JP Morgan in London.

From 1999 to 2006, Eric was a long/short portfolio manager on the equity proprietary desk at Exane, in charge of the statistical arbitrage book and long/short fundamental investments in financials.

Joanna Thompson has been a member of 100 Women in Hedge Funds since 2008, was one of the founding members of our group in Paris, and took over the leadership of the very enthusiastic and capable team when Olivia Bernard stood down in 2013.
